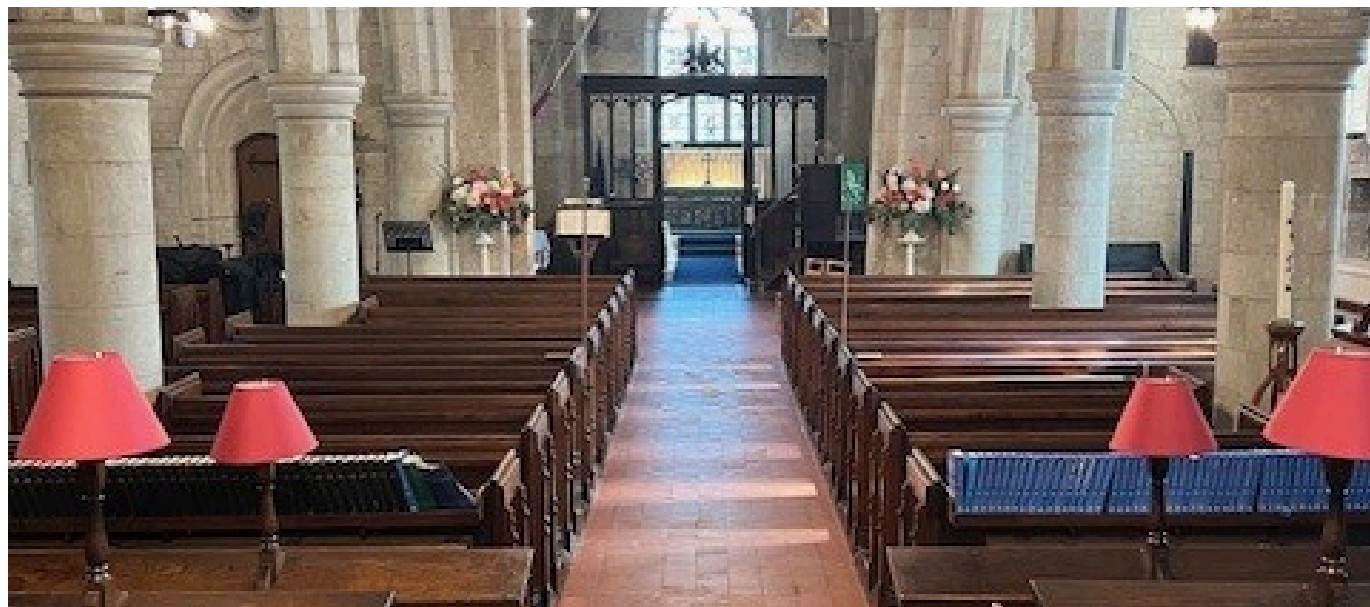

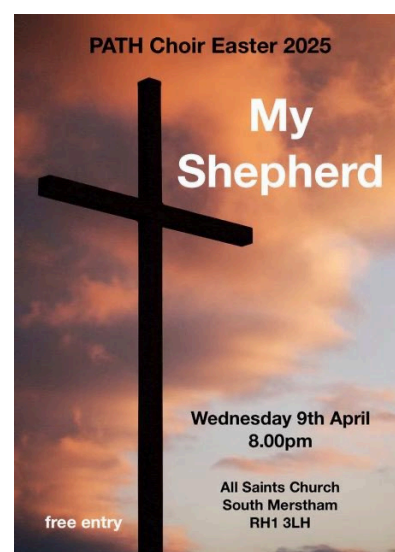

APCM - 06th April, 11.30am

The PCC is required to hold an APCM (Annual Parochial Church meeting) at which reports are shared, accounts approved, new members and officers are elected, and questions may be asked about any area of the church's ministry. Anyone may attend the annual meeting and raise questions.

At the APCM each year we have to appoint church wardens and fill any PCC vacancies. Both Tom and Jen are standing to be warden again. If anyone else wishes to stand please speak to Hannah in person or by phone.

Two members of the PCC have completed their first three year term. Both are standing for re-election. In addition we have one Deanery Synod casual vacancy which will be for a one year term. If you wish to stand for election to any of these positions please speak to Hannah for the correct forms. Nominations for PCC and Deanery Synod members can be received at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (provided there is evidence of acceptance by the nominee).

CHIPSTEAD HOME GUARD COMMENCED IN MARCH 1940 AND WAS ACTIVE UNTIL IT WAS DISBANDED LATE IN 1944. THEY WERE EVENTUALLY ESTABLISHED AS THE 19TH PLATOON OF KINGSWOOD'S F COMPANY OF THE 8TH SURREY (REIGATE) BATTALION.
