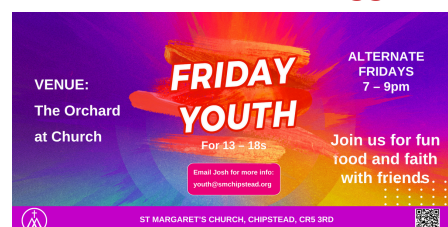

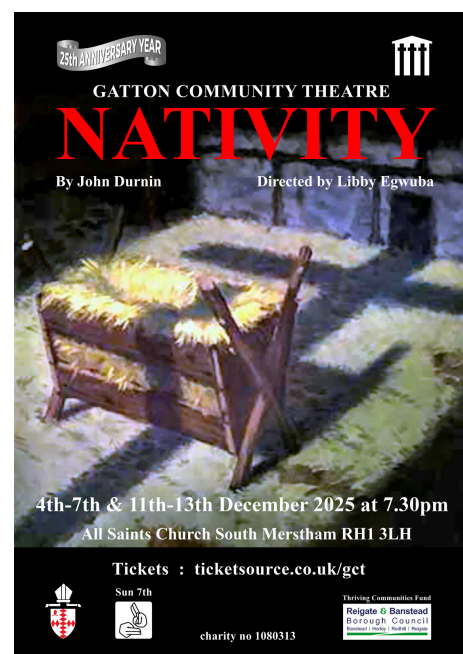
Sunday, 9th November:
